CHALLENGING

For five weeks this summer- 8 July until about 12 August 2013- I intend to complete the UK National Three Peaks Challenge with a difference. I'm calling it, 'The Three Peaks Extra Challenge', climbing the highest three mountains in Wales, England and Scotland/UK. I am going to walk Snowdon, walk to Scafell Pike and climb that. Then walk to Ben Nevis and finish by climbing that. The Three Peaks website, Nick Johnston, (21/11/11), wrote, 'We're not aware of anyone having walked the entire Three Peaks Challenge route, so as far as we're aware this would set a new record.'

I am a long distance walker who works as a Geography teacher at The British School of Amsterdam. I enjoy setting challenges for myself and seeing different parts of countries that I walk through. My parents introduced me to the great outdoors at a very young age. We camped, fished and walked on our family

holidays. When younger, I attended both the Cubs and Scouts. My long distance walking started in 2007 with England's Coast to Coast walk (195 miles/314 km) and since then I've done some form of walking each summer. This summer's expedition is, what I'm calling, 'The Three Peaks Extra Challenge' in the UK...

I contacted Ed Stafford, the first person ever to walk the whole length of the River Amazon and he said, 'Please feel free to quote me on your site as being a supporter of what you are doing - and have a great time.'

Rules:

1. I must climb Snowdon, Scafell Pike and Ben Nevis and walk the whole distance in-between
2. If I am to use transport I MUST return to the point I first used it and then continue walking
3. I must carry all my kit needed for the whole expedition (clothes, tent, sleeping bag etc.), including up and down each mountain
4. I am to keep an accurate and detailed route card with the date/ time, location (including grid reference), name and signature of local people to verify my locations

The distance is about 465 miles/745 km. I intend to collect money for The Scout Association.




