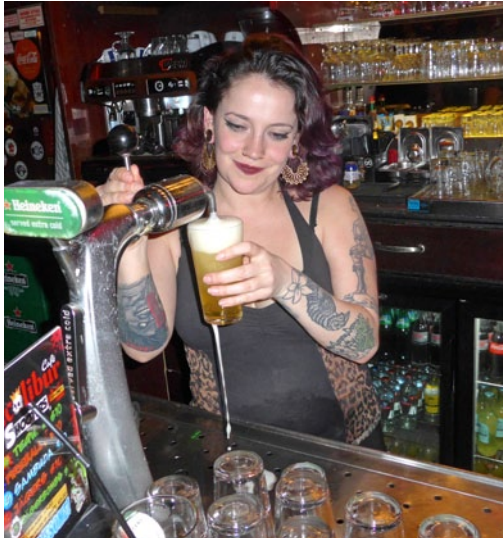

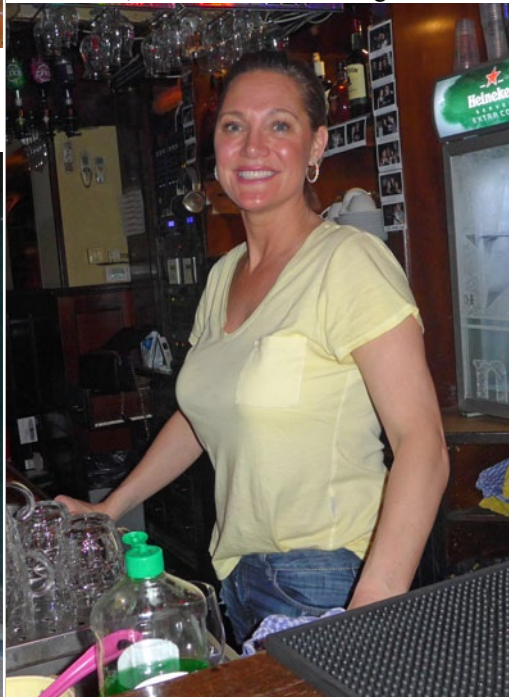
# Page Three

Enjoy your Stun.

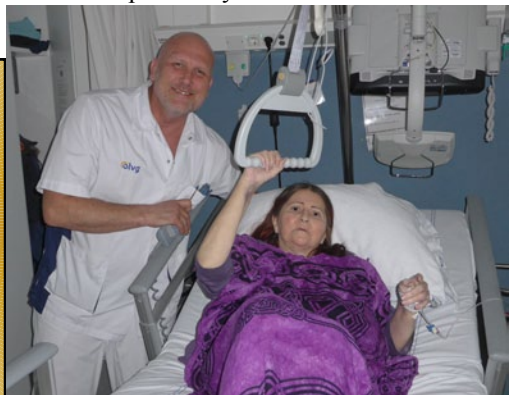
