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

BEING FRANK ON FOOTBALL

The race for the Premier League title is really hotting up and in my view, there are only two teams who can win it. Manchester City have clawed back the points that Liverpool had in their favour, and The Reds' goalless draw at Old Trafford on Sunday could be seen as two points dropped, given the fact that the home side had lost three players to injury even before the half-time cuppa.

Tottenham baffle to deceive. They beat Borussia Dortmund 3-0 in the Champions League a few days since, only to lose to struggling Burnley at Turf Moor on Sunday and it is this inconsistency that will cost them dearly. Ironically, Harry Kane was back and equalized for the visitors, but that was before a controversial corner was awarded to the home side, which led to their winning. Spurs boss Mauricio Pochettino was less than impressed with the officiating and now faces disciplinary action from the Football Association, having approached Mike Dean immediately after the final whistle blew. He was incensed by a number of decisions that did not go his way and his normally calm dexterity was tested to the full in this one.

The front two have a five point lead on Spurs, and I have always felt that the Premier League will be decided by the two front runners. The Citizens are favourites, but if they do win it, then it will not be by anything like the same margin as last season, and remember, they have to visit Old Trafford too!

Being involved in four competitions means that to be successful in all of them you need a very big squad. City have that and they will need it too, having battled away in extra time with Chelsea to lift the Carabao Cup on penalties in an enthralling tie. Pep Guardiola knows all about the potential pitfalls and said, after raising his second domestic trophy of the season, (Community Shield the first) that life does not get any easier. "Being in four competitions is so demanding, so tough. We don't know where we are going to arrive."

And there lies the problem; French defender Laporte will be missing for some weeks but what is perhaps more concerning is the injury to Fernandinho, who limped off just before the beginning of extra time at Wembley and was replaced with Danilo. The

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last time he was absent, City's form tipped discernibly and he is the one player they do not have a natural replacement for.

As for Chelsea, well after their 6-0 drubbing at the Etihad recently, this was a far better performance but the confusion that led to their goalkeeper refusing to go off when Sarri wanted to substitute him was both bizarre and quite absurd.

Kepa Arrizabalaga refused to leave the field even though his number was raised and in obvious frustration, manager Maurizio Sarri stomped around Wembley like a man possessed! Arrizabalaga had been suffering from cramp but waved away the coaching staff as they tried to get him off the field.

If however the manager had succeeded, then I feel sure former City man and penalty saving specialist Willy Caballero would have performed much better between the sticks and probably saved Sergio Aquero's weak penalty that Arrizabalaga let alarmingly trickle through his arms. I don't think Sarri will last the course and will soon go in much the same dramatic way as Frenchman Claude Puel, who has been a bit unlucky again, as he was at Southampton. He may not be the most charismatic character in the game, but he does produce sides that can play good football. Lady Luck is something that he has not had a lot of however and sadly, he struggled to engage with the fans.
