



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

BEING FRANK ON FOOTBALL

We begin at the top of the Premier League table, where Arsenal continue to sit proudly at the top, with a commanding 5 point lead on Manchester City.

When Arsenal were defeated recently by the Citizens, many believed that the Gunners would capitulate, but the complete opposite has occurred and they seem to have gone from strength to strength ever since. The latest club to suffer their wrath was beleaguered Everton, who succumbed to an emphatic defeat at the Emirates Stadium, where they went down to a 4-0 defeat.

For Everton boss Sean Dyche, it has been a mixed bag of results since he took over from Frank Lampard. In five games so far his stats read: two wins and three losses. The Toffees still find themselves in those relegation places, and more alarmingly is the fact that they are now conceding lots of goals and are struggling to score goals.

Dyche started his reign as Everton manager with a win over Arsenal at Goodison Park, which may have hinted at a possible revival, but fast forward to this hammering and the brutal reality is clear. They cannot score goals and if you cannot win games with goals then

your defence has to stay strong because one single goal is invariably not enough to get over the line.

In his two victories against Arsenal and Leeds United, they managed to win by a solitary goal so it can be done, but if you look at who scored those winning goals under Dyche, they were defenders. Former Burnley man James Tarkowski and veteran full-back Seamus Coleman were the heroes, but where else can they expect to get goals from? Dominic Calvert Lewin is a natural centre forward but he is nearly always injured, and this season he has just one goal to his name, which speaks volumes I guess.

A complete lack of confidence suggests that when Everton fall behind they do not have the self-belief to force their way back into games because they lack any serious attacking threat. Demarai Gray is their top scorer but he has just five goals to his name, and under Dyche he is usually benched anyway.

Dwight McNeil was sold by Dyche when he was the boss of Burnley but so far he has been one of the few bright sparks in the Everton team, and we know that midfielder Alex Iwobi can wade in with a few, as can

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Conor Cody, but he is another defender so where does that take us?

This weekend, Everton visit Nottingham Forest and it now assumes even greater importance as the Toffees face yet another season in deep crisis. They cannot afford to lose this one, that's for sure!

Manchester United's revival is as much about Marcus Rashford as anything else, and I cannot get my head around why England manager Gareth Southgate left him on the bench for most of their World Cup campaign.

Dutchman Erik ten Hag deserves much credit for Manchester United's change of fortunes, which saw them lift the Carabao Cup with a good victory over Newcastle United at Wembley, but he surely knows that it is Marcus Rashford who is going a long way to make this happen.

It meant Manchester United were back among the honours, after last tasting success six years ago, when they were victorious in the Europa League under Jose Mourinho, and won this competition in the very same campaign.

Over in Scotland, Celtic are running away with the title again I see and are 9 points clear of Rangers, who occupy second spot. They also defeated their staunchest rivals to win the League Cup last week, so one side of Glasgow is very happy at the moment and for good reason!
