





The Posh under Darren Ferguson still have a chance of sneaking into 6th place in the table, but they would have to rely on other results going their way, if they were to win at Barnsley on the last day of the league season.

And congrats too to Burnley and Sheffield United who will grace the Premier League again next season! Luton, Middlesbrough, Coventry City and Millwall are on the front grid to battle it out for that final promotion place.
